Trailer Policy

Church Trailer Use

- Booking for the trailer will need to be made through the church office
- Trailer keys to be collected from the church office and must be returned as soon as practicable following use.
- The keys will only be available to the approved driver
- Drivers must be a person 25 years of age or having full license for more than three years.
- The tow vehicle is to have a current WOF
- The tow vehicle is to have appropriate tow rating for the expected loads
- The driver is responsible to check WOF and registration are current.
- Trailers are not to be towed further than 2 hours travel time from Te Awamutu.
- The driver will ensure that the trailer is left in a clean and tidy condition with all rubbish removed and any spills or dirt cleaned from the floor and surfaces.
- All road rules will be followed
- Any traffic offences incurred are the responsibility of the driver of the vehicle at the time the
 offence occurred.
- The driver may be responsible for the costs involved in the event of accidental damage
- Refer to the TABC Trailer Procedures for the operating instructions
